

2018 SPIN ON RULES WITHIN THE SFNL - NO SURPRISES...

- > Deliberate rushed behind not paid in SFNL
- > Deliberate out of bounds paid
- > Once the goal umpire has been given the all clear and signalled his decision the defender may bring the ball back into play.
 - Please note: If a player knocks a ball out of play on the full after a ball up or throw in the free kick shall be awarded to the opposition. this includes hitting the point post on the full also.
- > 50m penalty paid for time wasting, abuse, not giving the ball back correctly and or promptly overstepping the mark or within the protected area.
- > 5m protected at set kick not 10m
- ➤ Hands allowed in back as long there is no second motion/action i.e. push.
- > Third man up rule adopted.
- A poor throw in by the boundary umpire will result in a throw up by field umpire 10m to 15m in side the boundary line.
- > Deliberate interference by player other than nominated ruckman will result in free kick awarded against offending player in ball in and throw in
- ➤ 1m separation for ruckman until ball leaves umpire's hands.
- ➤ A centre circle line will separate the ruckman at the centre bounce.
- A player drawing a free kick from ducking head or falling into tackle will be asked to play on and if tackled correctly must dispose of ball by either hand or foot.
- A free kick may be paid against the coaches box for abuse. The free kick will be awarded against the offending team where play is stopped or after a goal in the centre prior to a ball up.
- All other free kicks as per laws of the game shall be paid.
 Please note: The ball player must be protected and be given reasonable time to dispose of the ball
- Where an emergency field umpire has been appointed to the game, he/she has the normal powers to report and through one of the officiating field umpires may send off.
- > Yellow and Red card are used in the SFNL No green cards, if you are unsure, ask your coaches.
- As per 2017, any incident bought to the attention of the Director of Umpiring by an officiating umpire may be referred to the General Manger Operations for referral to tribunal as per rule 18.1 of the SFNL By-Laws.
